## Village Junior Counselors must:

- 1. Understand and fulfill the role of friend and staff/leader assistant during the experience. The delegation leader takes full responsibility for the children en route to camp, while in camp, and en route home. Junior Counselors are asked to provide support for leaders and staff in the village while adult leaders remain legally responsible for the children.
- 2. Develop good rapport with the children, their leaders, and the staff promoting a group feeling among all of them.
- 3. Prepare booklets/scrapbooks about yourself for all village participants.
- 4. Be responsible for seeing that forms required by CISV are completed properly and submitted to the Chapter contact person and to the village director/staff or planner on time.
- 5. Become aware of any health problems the children may have, and be able to help adult leaders deal with such problems if they arise at the village.
